## Report

On 6th July 2001, the Gambling Control Committee made an Act delegating certain of its functions under Regulation 6(13B) of the Gambling (Licensing Provisions) (Jersey) Regulations 1965, as amended.

The terms of the delegation were recorded in an Act of the Committee as follows -

"B1. The Committee, in pursuance of Article 36A of the States of Jersey Law 1966, as amended, decided, will immediate effect, to delegate to the Gambling and Lottery Controller its functions under Regulation 6(13B) of the Gambling (Licensing Provisions) (Jersey) Regulations 1965, as amended, as follows -

Legislation: Gambling (Licensing Provisions) (Jersey)

Regulations 1965

**Delegate:** The Gambling and Lottery Controller

**Functions** In pursuance of paragraph (13) of Regulation 6 delegated: of the Regulations, the authority to approve the

appointment of a person to act as manager of a licensed betting or credit betting office, on the condition that the person was fit and proper to carry on the licence, subject to appropriate

background reports.

The Greffier of the States was requested to arrange for this Act to be presented to the States for information in due course.".
