Report

On 10th January 2001, the Health and Social Services Committee made an Act delegating certain of its functions under the Children (Jersey) Law 1969, as amended.

The terms of the delegation were recorded in an Act of the Committee as follows -

"A4. The Committee, in pursuance of Article 36A of the States of Jersey Law 1966, as amended, received an noted the attached formal statement (designated Committee Paper CP/HSSC/02/01) which detailed certain powers delegated to the President by the Committee.

The Committee accordingly approved the contents of the aforementioned statement and requested that it be presented to the States for information at the earliest available opportunity. The Greffier of the States was requested to take the necessary action.".
