- When the various re-registrations are deducted from the official birth registrations shown above, the actual number of children born in the Island in 2001 was 973. This is three less than last year and continues the downward trend in the birth rate since 1994.
- (ii) The number of marriages performed in the Office of the Superintendent Registrar in 2001 was 419. This was 122 fewer than in 2000. The most popular months for marriages were August (117) and September (107).
- (iii) During the year 205 couples came to the Island to be married. This is 82 fewer than last year. The most popular months were September (40), August (34) and July (32).
