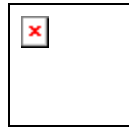

Report

On 22nd January 2002, the Gambling Control Committee made an Act delegating certain of its functions under Regulation 6(13B) of the Gambling (Licensing Provisions) (Jersey) Regulations 1965, as amended.

The terms of the delegation were recorded in an Act of the Committee as follows -

“B1. The Committee, in pursuance of Article 36A of the States of Jersey Law 1966, as amended, decided, with immediate effect, to delegate to the Executive Director and Lottery Controller its functions under Regulation 6(13B) of the Gambling (Licensing Provisions) (Jersey) Regulations 1965, as amended, as follows -

Legislation: Gambling (Licensing Provisions) (Jersey) Regulations 1965

Delegate: (a) the Executive Director

(b) the Lottery Controller

Functions delegated: In pursuance of paragraph (13) of Regulation 6 of the Regulations, the authority to approve the appointment of a person to act as manager of a licensed betting or credit betting office, on the condition that the person was fit and proper to carry on the licence, subject to appropriate background reports.

The Greffier of the States was requested to arrange for this Act to be presented to the States for information at the earliest opportunity.”.
