## STATES OF JERSEY LAW 1966, AS AMENDED: DELEGATION OF FUNCTIONS- CIVIL SERVICE ADMINISTRATION

Presented to the States on 28th January 2003 by the Policy and Resources Committee

## **REPORT**

On 17th January 2003, the Policy and Resources Committee made an Act delegating certain of its functions under the Civil Service Administration (Jersey) Law 1948, as amended.

The terms of the delegation were recorded in an Act of the Committee as follows –

"A11. The Committee, with reference to its Act No. A5(e) of 19th December 2002, considered the delegated functions contained within R.C.39/1997 entitled 'States of Jersey Law 1966, as amended - Delegation of Functions: Civil Service Administration'.

The Committee confirmed that it wished to continue the arrangements for delegating powers to the Human Resources officers, as detailed in the aforementioned report. It noted that there had been no alteration to the scope of the delegation, and in pursuance of the States of Jersey Law 1966, as amended, it agreed to delegate to the relevant Chief Officer(s) concerned of functions under the following legislation which was subordinate to the Civil Service Administration (Jersey) Law 1948, as amended –

- (a) Civil Service Administration (General) (Jersey) Rules 1949, as amended;
- (b) Civil Service Administration (Salaries) (Jersey) Order 1982, as amended;
- (c) Civil Service Administration (Educational Allowances) (Jersey) Rules 1951, as amended;
- (d) Civil Service Administration (Travelling Allowances) (Jersey) Rules 1950, as amended;
- (e) Civil Service Administration (Language Proficiency Allowances) (Jersey) Rules 1973;
- (f) Civil Service Administration (Shift Allowances) (Jersey) Order 1979;
- (g) Civil Service Administration (Jersey) Law 1953;

together with legislation subordinate to the Public Employees Retirement) (Jersey) Law 1967, as amended –

- (i) Public Employees (Contributory Retirement Scheme) (General) (Jersey) Regulations 1989;
- (ii) Public Employees (Contributory Retirement Scheme) (General) (Existing Members) (Jersey) Regulations 1989;
- (iii) Public Employees (Contributory Retirement Scheme) (New Members) (General) (Jersey) Regulations 1989;
- (iv) Public Employees (Contributory Retirement Scheme) (Former Hospital Scheme) (Jersey) Regulations 1992.

The Committee decided that the delegation would have immediate effect and the Greffier of the States was requested to make the necessary arrangements for the matter to be presented to the States."
