## STATES OF JERSEY LAW 1966, AS AMENDED: DELEGATION OF FUNCTIONS– ESTATES MANAGEMENT

## **REPORT**

On 2nd April 2003, the Health and Social Services Committee made an Act delegating certain of its functions under Article 36A of the States of Jersey Law 1966.

The terms of the delegation were recorded in an Act of the Committee as follows –

“A13. The Committee, with reference to Act No. A10 of 3rd October 2001, of the Committee as previously constituted, received a report, dated 2nd April 2003, from the Director of Estates, regarding a proposal to raise the levels at which certain transactions in land might be approved under delegated authority.

The Committee noted that the proposed levels were in accordance with new Standing Orders, paragraph 1 (1)(a) – (h), approved by the States on 1st October 2002.

The Committee, in accordance with Article 36A of the States of Jersey Law 1966, approved the proposed delegation of authority to the Chief Executive or the Director of Estates to the level of the new Standing Orders or of any new Standing Orders relating to property matters, as might be approved by the States in the future.

The Greffier of the States was directed to arrange for this Act to be presented to the States for information in due course and to send a copy of this Act to the Finance and Economics, Environment and Public Services and Housing Committees for information.”
