REPORT

On 6th June 2003, the Housing Committee made an Act delegating certain of its functions under the Housing (General Provisions) (Jersey) Regulations 1970, as amended.

The terms of the delegation were recorded in an Act of the Committee as follows –

“A8. The Committee, having considered the process for the consideration of applications for the grant of consent to applications under Regulation 1(1)(j) of the Housing (General Provisions) (Jersey) Regulations 1970, as amended, delegated to the Chief Executive Officer and, in his absence, the Director of Housing Control and, in his absence, the Housing Control Manager authority to approve extensions to existing consents, or the grant of permanent consents, in cases where such approval was strongly recommended by the Department and where there was a significant degree of urgency for such applications to be considered without delay.

The Chief Executive Officer was directed to take the necessary action, and the Greffier of the States was directed to present a copy of this Act to the States for their information.”
