STATES OF JERSEY LAW 1966, AS AMENDED: DELEGATION OF FUNCTIONS– PRISON OFFICERS (JERSEY) REGULATIONS 1957

**Presented to the States on 8th March 2005
by the Home Affairs Committee**

REPORT

On 28th February 2005, the Home Affairs Committee made an Act delegating certain of its functions under the Prison Officers (Jersey) Regulations 1957.

The terms of the delegation were recorded in an Act of the Committee as follows –

“A1. The Committee received a report from the Prison Governor requesting delegated power. This report was designated Committee Paper (CP-HAF/1/05).

Accordingly, the Committee, in pursuance of Article 36A of the States of Jersey Law 1966, as amended decided (with immediate effect) to delegate to the Prison Governor functions under Regulation 17 of the Prison Officers (Jersey) Regulations 1957.

Legislation:	Prison Officers (Jersey) Regulations 1957, Regulation 17.
Delegate:	The Prison Governor.
Function delegated:	All the powers contained in Regulation 17(1)(a) to (f) of the above legislation.
Scope of delegation:	To reduce pay for a limited period, unless the period of reduction had been extended for a further offence against discipline. Notification of all disciplinary hearings (leading to awards covered by (a) to (d) of the aforesaid Regulation) to be advised to the Home Affairs Committee as soon as practicable.

The Committee agreed to present the aforementioned delegated functions to the States as a Rapport et Correspondance and requested the Greffier of the States to make the necessary arrangements.”

Re-issue Note
