

The library is getting busier in 2004

- Library visits increased by over 17% from 84,000 to a total of 566,321. This means that each working day there were about 1,303 visitors to the town library and over 500 at the branch library (225 public and 375 pupil visitors).
- The number of items borrowed at the central library increased by 1.4% and at the branch by 5%. This indicates a reverse in the decline of 4% overall since 2000.
- There were over 43,000 session bookings in the Open Learning Centre with 84% of the available hours fully booked.
- On average, 199 information enquiries were answered each day at the town library and 39 at the branch library.
- Study rooms provided 6,916 hours of private study time during the year, an increase of 20% on 2003 bookings.
- 14,210 new items were added to stock.
- 2,113 reservations were satisfied including 382 items obtained from other library authorities.
- 4,341 items were renewed using the library website.
- 66 people use the "house" delivery service and 314 visits were made in 2004.
- 52 visits were made to deliver books to 34 Nursing Homes and Day Care Centres.
- A further 5,760 entries to the were added to the computer index to the Jersey Evening Post maintained by the library staff, which now stands at 83,280 records.

- There were 260 activities and events organised in the library and attended by 6,244 children.
- Opening hours in the local studies library were extended and 381 people used the research facilities and specialist support of the local studies librarian.
