To lease two office suites and two car parking spaces at Broadcasting House, Rouge Bouillon (plan reference 1496/3) to Highlands Spring Ltd. for a term of 10 months—commencing 1st March 2006 — at a rental of £9,600.00 per annum.

(b) Land transaction -
