The Minister for Home Affairs has the honour to present the following statistics for the year 2005.

1. Statement as to the number of births, deaths and marriages registered in the 12 parishes of the Island during the year 2005.

- Notes: (i) When the various re-registrations are deducted from the official birth registrations shown above, the actual number of children born in the Island in 2005 was 969. This is 2 less than in 2004.
 - (ii) The number of marriages performed in the Office of the Superintendent Registrar in 2005 was 257. This was 9 fewer than in 2004. Taking into account that the Register Office was closed for the month of November for refurbishment, the number of marriages in the Register Office would have been similar to that of 2004. A further 185 civil marriages were celebrated in Approved Premises. This number is very similar to those held in Approved Premises in 2004. The most popular months for marriages were August (109), July (102) and September (89).
 - (iii) During the year 199 couples came to the Island to be married. This is 9 more than in 2004. The most popular months were July (36), followed by June (32), and August (31).
 - (iv) The number of deaths registered in 2005 is 4 more than the previous year.
