STATES OF JERSEY LAW 2005: DELEGATION OF FUNCTIONS – HOUSING DEPARTMENT – DELEGATED POWERS TO THE ASSISTANT MINISTER

Presented to the States on 1st June 2006 by the Minister for Housing

REPORT

On 19th May 2006, the Minister for Housing made a decision delegating certain of his functions under Article 28 (1) of the States of Jersey Law 2005.

The terms of the delegation were recorded in a ministerial decision as follows –

Article 28(1) of the States of Jersey Law 2005 permits a Minister to delegate, wholly or partly, functions conferred upon or vested in the Minister by or under this Law or any other enactment or any enactment of the United Kingdom having effect in Jersey.

It also states that the delegation of functions by a Minister under the Article shall not prevent the Minister exercising those functions personally.

On 19th May 2006, in accordance with Article 28(1) of the States of Jersey Law 2005, the Minister for Housing, Senator T.J. Le Main, delegated all powers and functions in respect of the Housing Department, including all other areas where the Minister would otherwise have to act and be advised, to his Assistant Minister, Deputy J.A. Hilton, for any periods when he is unavailable or out of the Island.
