On 9th February 2007, the Minister for Economic Development made a decision delegating certain of his functions under the legislation as detailed below.

The terms of the delegation were recorded in a ministerial decision as follows -

The Minister, under Article 28 of the States of Jersey Law 2005, approved the delegation of his powers for the legislation shown in the table below.
