## **STATES OF JERSEY LAW 2005: DELEGATION OF FUNCTIONS – HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES**

## REPORT

On 23rd March 2007, the Minister for Health and Social Services made a decision delegating certain of his functions under Article 28 of the States of Jersey Law 2005.

The terms of the delegation were recorded in a ministerial decision as follows –

<b>Legislation:</b>	Drainage (Jersey) Law 2005
<b>Delegate:</b>	Head of Health Protection Services Health Protection or, in his absence, his nominated deputy.
<b>Functions delegated:</b>	Article 15(2)– to act as the point of consultation on behalf of the Minister of Health and Social Services for matters relating to the repair of sewers and drains, in the interests of public health.
<b>Scope of delegation:</b>	To consult with the Minister for Transport and Technical Services, or officers acting on the Minister’s behalf, on work to be undertaken under Article 15(1) relating to the repair of sewers and drains.

<b>Legislation:</b>	Health Care (Registration) (Jersey) Law 1995
<b>Delegate:</b>	Head of Health Protection Services or, in his absence, his nominated deputy.
<b>Functions delegated:</b>	Article 5(2)– if the application for annual registration is not made in the month of December, the name of the registered person to be removed from the register.
<b>Scope of delegation:</b>	To remove registrations if the applicant fails to meet the requirement specified in Article 5(2).
