Decision(s): Under Standing Order 168(3) the Minister for Treasury and Resources hereby notifies the States that he has accepted the recommendation of the Property Holdings Department to agree to the following –

(a) Land transaction –

The sale of Field 823, Le Clos de la Verte Rue, Trinity, amounting to 3 vergées 20 perch, to the National Trust for Jersey for £10 with each party paying their own legal costs.

The contract of sale is to include a covenant that the field must never be developed.

The Minister hereby authorises the Attorney General and the Greffier of the States to pass any contract which is required to be passed on behalf of the Public.

After the expiry of 15 days following presentation to the States the transaction may be concluded.

(b) Land transaction –

The sale of Fields 849 and 851, Trinity, amounting to 9 vergées 7 perch, to the Royal Jersey Agricultural and Horticultural Society for £40,000, with each party paying their own legal costs.

The contract of sale is to include a covenant that the fields must never be developed.

The Minister hereby authorises the Attorney General and the Greffier of the States to pass any contract which is required to be passed on behalf of the Public.

After the expiry of 15 days following presentation to the States the transaction may be concluded.
