REMUNERATION OF STATES' EMPLOYEES 2007

Presented to the States on 17th June 2008 by the Chief Minister

REPORT

- 1. In accordance with normal practice, the States Treasurer has included Notes regarding the remuneration of States employees in the Financial Report and Accounts for 2007 (Appendix A).
- 2. In order to provide more information to States Members, the States Employment Board is providing details of the types and numbers of posts to be found within the remuneration bands used by the Treasurer in the Notes to the Accounts (Appendix B).
- 3. During 2007, 464 Public Sector Employees (7.73% of the total) earned in excess of £70,000. These earnings include overtime, standby and other allowances in addition to basic salary. They also include the employer's pension contribution of 15.6% that is applied to basic salary.
- 4. From Appendix A it can be seen that 141 additional employees from nontrading departments were earning £70,000+ in 2007 compared with 2006.

Of these, 101 were brought into the £70,000+ pay bracket following the 2007 pay award.

The remaining 40 can be explained as follows –

- Four were appointed to a senior post partway through 2006 and therefore their earnings in that year did not take them over £70,000; however, their earnings in 2007 did lift them into this bracket:
- One Civil Servant and one Teacher were in receipt of a market or acting-up supplement;
- Five new medical posts at Health;
- 18 staff on account of receiving standby and overtime payments, (often relating to being or call):
 - ➤ 8 Civil Servants Pathology Laboratory
 - ➤ 2 Civil Servants Computer Services
 - ➤ 1 Manual Worker Technician
 - ➤ 1 Paramedic
 - ➤ 5 Police Constables
 - ➤ 1 Prison Officer
- 11 Nurses and Midwives following the revision of the job families agreement and the resulting back pay.

A Law Officer retired during 2007 reducing the overall numbers by one.

- 5. Employees who earn in excess of £70,000 include Senior Civil Servants, Chief Officers, States/Judicial Appointments, Doctors/Consultants/Specialists, Senior Fire, Police and Prison Officers, Head Teachers, Highlands College Management, Law Draftsmen, Legal Advisers, some Nurses and Midwives and one Paramedic and three Manual Workers earning high levels of overtime pay.
- 6. It should be further noted that the term 'Civil Servant' includes a number of professions such as States Vet, Official Analyst, Senior Ambulance Officers, Air Traffic Controllers, Meteorologists, Engineers, Accountants, Customs and Immigration Officers, Modern Matrons, Physiotherapists, Pathologists, Microbiologists, Radiologists and Pharmacists.
