MEETINGS OF THE STATES IN 2009

STATES GREFFE

REPORT

The Privileges and Procedures Committee is required to fix dates for States meetings for the following year no later than the end of September each year. Standing Orders 3 and 4 read as follows –

3 Sessions of the States

- (1) There shall be 2 sessions of the States in each year during which they shall meet.
- (2) The 1st session shall start on the 3rd Tuesday in January and end no later than the last Tuesday in July.
- (3) The 2nd session shall start on the 2nd Tuesday in September and end no later than the 3rd Tuesday in December.

4 Planning days for meetings of the States

- (1) The PPC shall, no later than the end of September in each year, present to the States a list of days for meetings of the States in the 1st and 2nd sessions in the following year.
- (2) Ordinarily, a meeting day is a Tuesday.
- (3) The list may include continuation days.

The Committee has now fixed meeting dates for 2009 as shown on the attached list.

PPC agreed last year that, as a matter of principle, States meetings should not take place during the school holidays if at all possible. The proposed dates on the attached list have therefore been drawn up in line with this decision.

In accordance with the requirements of Standing Orders the first meeting of 2009 is on the third Tuesday of January, namely 20th January. The normal fortnightly cycle is disrupted by the February half-term and there is therefore a 3 week gap between the proposed meeting on 3rd February and the next on 24th February.

In late March it is proposed that the States meet on consecutive weeks on 24th March and then on 31st March as there would otherwise be an unduly long gap in April because of the Easter holidays. Similarly in May, because of the half-term holiday at the end of May, it is proposed that 2 meetings be held one week after the other, namely 12th May and 19th May. The remaining meetings of the first session follow the normal fortnightly pattern.

The second session begins on the 2nd Tuesday of September as required by Standing Orders. Because of the International Air Display on Thursday 10th September it is proposed that the States meet only in the morning of that day with the meeting to continue on Friday 11th September if necessary. The remaining meetings of the second session follow the regular fortnightly cycle without any difficulty, although the last meeting on 8th December 2009 is only one week after the meeting of 1st December.

The proposed schedule for 2009 allows for 21 scheduled meetings, which is broadly in line with the usual number in recent years.
