## MEETINGS OF THE STATES IN 2025

## **REPORT**

The Privileges and Procedures Committee (PPC) is required to fix dates for States Assembly meetings for the following year no later than the end of September each year. Following a decision taken by PPC a number of years ago, the dates are drafted to avoid meetings during any school holiday periods. In 2025, School term dates are as follows:

- Spring term: 6th January to 4th April (half term 17th to 21st February)
- Summer term: 22nd April to 18th July (half term 27th May to 30th May)
- Autumn term: 2nd September to 18th December (half term 27th October to 31st October)

Standing Orders 3 and 4 provide that –

### **3 Sessions of the States**

1. There shall be 2 sessions of the States in each year during which they shall meet;
2. The 1st session shall start on the 3rd Tuesday in January and end no later than the last Tuesday in July;
3. The 2nd session shall start on the 2nd Tuesday in September and end no later than the 3rd Tuesday in December.

### **4 Planning days for meetings of the States**

1. The PPC shall, no later than the end of September in each year, present to the States a list of days for meetings of the States in the 1st and 2nd sessions in the following year;
2. Ordinarily, a meeting day is a Tuesday;
3. The list may include continuation days.

In 2021, the States Assembly agreed to move to a 3 weekly cycle, therefore, the meeting dates for 2025 are detailed as an Appendix to this Report. School holidays have been avoided and the dates provide for 16 meetings (plus Liberation Day) including Friday as an additional continuation day.

As required by Standing Orders, the first meeting of 2025 will be on 21st January which is the third Tuesday of January. The 3 weekly cycle continues throughout the Spring term, avoiding meeting during the Spring half term (17th – 21st February). After Liberation Day, which falls on Friday 9th May, the States will then meet on 13th May, avoiding the summer half term (27th May to 30th May). The cycle continues with a 2 weekly date of 3rd June returning to the 3 weekly cycle until the last meeting before the summer recess, which will be on 8th July. The Committee proposes this date so as to avoid the school holidays (beginning 19th July).

As required by Standing Orders, the first meeting of the second session will be on the second Tuesday in September, namely 9th September 2025. The schools break for Christmas on 18th December 2025.

The first meeting of 2026 will be on Tuesday 20th January 2026.
