Assisted Dying Review Panel: Clarifications and Updates on the Proposed Assisted Dying Legislation

I would like to thank you for your continued engagement and collaboration on the proposed assisted dying legislation. As we move forward in our preparations to launch a review, we would be grateful for your response to the following points of clarification:

Previous Case Studies

1. During the last States debate, a number of case studies were presented as an appendix, to illustrate the potential application of the proposed law. The panel found these very helpful. Could you please confirm whether these case studies remain relevant and appropriate for continued use? If they are no longer applicable, can updated or additional case studies related to the law be provided, and if so, when could these be made available?

Accessible Public Document

2. We would like to express our appreciation for your agreement to develop an accessible document to help islanders better understand the proposed law. Could you kindly advise when this document is expected to be published? Could the panel be forwarded a copy of this document as soon as it is available?

Briefing for All States Members

3. In the interest of ensuring all States Members are fully informed, could you confirm when a comprehensive briefing session will likely be scheduled to discuss the proposed legislation?

Costing of the Assisted Dying Service

4. Finally, the Panel notes the Resource and Financial Implication section of the report in [P.18/2024](#) and refers to the table below. We would welcome an update to this table with an additional column specifying the expected total costs associated with establishing and

operating an assisted dying service, including any anticipated ongoing financial implications.
