Draft Elections (Jersey) Amendment Law 202- ('P.28/2025')

Following the States Assembly debate on [the Draft Elections \(Jersey\) Amendment Law 202- \('P.28/2025'\)](#) on 14th May 2025, and the referral of P.28/2025 to Scrutiny under Standing Order 72, the Panel wishes to notify the Privileges and Procedures Committee ('PPC') of its intention to review the proposals.

The Panel is very mindful of the time sensitivity of this workstream and will take this into account when undertaking its review. The Panel is due to meet on Tuesday 20th May 2025 to discuss and agree its review approach, however, in the first instance, requests a private briefing from the PPC Chair and its Lead Officer on P.28/2025. Our Officers will make the necessary arrangements so that the briefing can be scheduled as soon as possible.

Additionally, whilst it is acknowledged that scrutiny of Propositions brought forward by the PPC is not a common occurrence, as a matter of course, the Panel wishes to request that going forward private briefings are provided to it on any draft legislation brought forward by the PPC ahead of lodging for debate in the States Assembly. In doing so, as main respondent, the Chair and Members of the Panel will be better informed ahead of any debate on any draft legislation which is lodged for States Assembly debate by the PPC.

The Panel would appreciate to receive a formal written response to confirm the above by no later than **Thursday 22nd May 2025**. Please be aware that it is the Panel's intention to publish the response it receives on the States Assembly website. However, should the information provided be confidential, please can you inform the Panel accordingly and the response will not be published.
