Draft Elections (Jersey) Amendment Law 202- ('P.28/2025')

Further to your letter dated 15th May 2025, I agree that in future, the Privileges and Procedures Committee will make arrangements to brief your Panel ahead of lodging any legislative amendments. Not only will this ensure that Corporate Services have a better understanding of the legislative changes proposed, but it will allow you to be better placed to make a judgement regarding whether the matter should be called in for review after the principles have been adopted.

Prior to lodging P.28, due to the nature of the administrative changes, the Committee and officers liaised with the Comité des Connétables and the Parish Secretaries.

Whilst Scrutiny of PPC's propositions has been rare to date, I acknowledge the benefit which can be derived from engaging with your Panel earlier in the process and hope that it will be a positive way forward.
