Dear President,

Amendments to the Regulation of Care (Jersey) Law 2014 – Panel Remit

I write to inform you that the Environment, Housing & Infrastructure Scrutiny Panel has been notified that the draft amendments to the Regulation of Care (Jersey) Law 2014, specifically those affecting hospital and ambulance services, are in their final drafting stages and are likely to be debated in the States Assembly in September.

We have arranged a joint briefing with the Health and Social Services Panel for 30th July 2025, however, given the subject matter and specialist nature of these amendments, I believe that it would not be appropriate for the EHI Panel to undertake this scrutiny.

Regrettably, we understand the Health Panel is currently unable to commit to a review and so, to ensure effective scrutiny of this important legislation we therefore seek the Scrutiny Liaison Committee's guidance on how best to proceed.

The Panel looks forward to receiving your response within five working days of receipt of this letter.
