### **La Collette Fuel Farm**

The Panel would be grateful if you could provide information on the lease and contractual arrangements for the Fuel Farm.

1. What further progress has been made by you and the Council of Ministers in relation to the Fuel Farm Lease Renewal?
2. During the States Assembly sitting on 13<sup>th</sup> May the Chief Minister indicated that further conversations would need to take place with you and the Council of Ministers in order to consider whether a break clause in the lease with the current operator would be appropriate 'to allow flexibility'. Has this happened and what was the conclusion of those discussions?
3. How do you envisage any lease or contractual arrangements changing in future in the best interests of the Island?
4. What other arrangements for enforcement mechanisms to ensure safety have now been discussed and how will these be reflected in contractual agreements?

In addition, the Panel would appreciate clarification on the tendering process:

5. Why was a decision taken not to put the contract out to competitive tender?
6. Were different approaches considered for the tender process, and what was ultimately determined to be the optimal route and why?
