COVID-19 Follow up

I write to inform you that the Public Accounts Committee (PAC) has agreed to undertake a COVID-19 Follow up Review. The Committee has agreed Terms of Reference for the review which are as follows:

1. To consider the completion of COVID-19 related actions agreed through recommendations of:
 - a. the Comptroller and Auditor General;
 - b. Jersey Independent Covid-19 Review;
 - c. Public Accounts Committee; and,
 - d. Scrutiny and Reviews Panels.
2. To identify any potential areas of scrutiny for future iterations of the Public Accounts Committee to undertake regarding COVID-19 resilience and readiness related recommendations.

As part of the evidence gathering process, the PAC would be grateful if you could provide an update on the current status of the accepted recommendations set out in the attached document. Where recommendations have been completed, please include details of how they were implemented, outlining any resulting changes, with supporting evidence such as relevant links, revised procedures, or new or updated policies.

These recommendations have been identified by the PAC from a range of reports, including those of the Comptroller and Auditor General, the Jersey Independent COVID-19 Review, the Public Accounts Committee, and Scrutiny Panels.

In addition, the PAC would welcome details of any further accepted recommendations relating to COVID-19 that may not be included in the attached document.

The PAC would be grateful if you could provide a response to these queries by 9th of February 2026. It is the intention of the PAC to publish both this letter and the response on the States Assembly website.
